
**Have you voted for us through Target Circle?** If not there's still time! See how you can help direct Target's giving to benefit SEALKIDS.

# What are nonverbal learning disabilities?



As I continue to read about my children's learning disabilities, I come across things that I have heard of but don't know much about. Recently I discovered nonverbal learning disabilities, a brain-based condition that affects skills such as abstract thinking and spatial relationships. Nonverbal learning disabilities affect a child's social skills, but not their speech or writing skills. Children with nonverbal learning disabilities tend to talk a lot, but they don't always share in a socially appropriate way which leads to challenges with making and keeping friends. Children with nonverbal learning disabilities have trouble understanding communication that is not verbal such as body language, tone of voice, and facial expressions. Learning differences can come in many forms and with the correct interventions the child affected thrives. As I navigate through this journey of learning differences with my own children, I work to educate myself on the challenges that other children face. I am excited to share what I have learned so that others who may have a child facing challenges can take the steps to help their child thrive.
