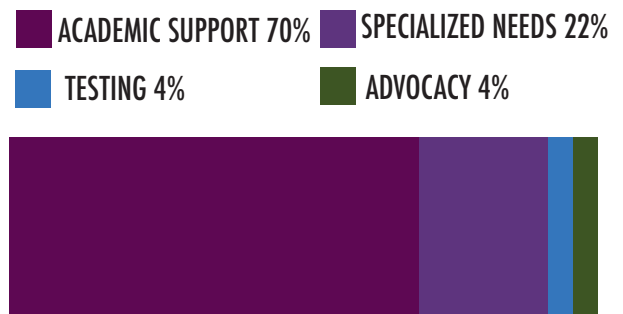
GRANT CYCLE 1 HIGHLIGHTS

- 235 grants were awarded to benefit NSW families
- 8,933 hours of educational services were awarded
- 100% of participants showed improvement in at least one area of measure
- 67% of grants served children with one or more diagnosed learning disabilities
- 100% of parents reported being satisfied with SEALKIDS' services
- 96.5% of parents report that after SEALKIDS' services they are better able to help their child reach their academic potential
- 90% of parents indicated that they will seek additional help from SEALKIDS

RESPONDING TO COVID-19

During our first Grant Cycle of 2020, the COVID-19 pandemic quickly and drastically changed the education landscape across the country, as well as the daily lives of the many families we serve. SEALKIDS adapted to continue to serve NSW families throughout this paradigm shift. As many students were no longer able to attend in-person classes and lost access to school district-provided special needs services, SEALKIDS' one-on-one interventions became even more essential to the academic success of the students we serve.

During this grant cycle, 15 grants ended early due to COVID-19 related safety concerns. The remainder of grants were fulfilled with online adaptations and continued one-on-one services. Some families received an increased number of service hours to help navigate the challenge of distance learning and increased family stress.

Despite difficult circumstances, families prioritized their SEALKIDS service and maintained an overall average attendance rate of 91% across all SEALKIDS programs.
